

The vision for Ksyen Regional Hospital was to deliver a resilient, state-of-the-art facility that expands healthcare capacity while offering a healing environment that enhances patient comfort and supports providers.

Valcoustics contributed expertise in acoustics across critical areas—such as surgical suites, neonatal care, and counselling spaces—ensuring the facility achieved its ambitious performance and sustainability goals.

The \$622.6M hospital now includes 78 private beds, a Level 3 trauma centre, expanded emergency and diagnostic services, and a new Seven Sisters long-term care facility. The integration of acoustical solutions adds lasting value by reducing stress, improving healing outcomes, and enhancing overall patient and staff experience.

The Mills Memorial Hospital Redevelopment, now operating as Ksyen Regional Hospital, involved the construction of a new acute care facility and integrated services centre. The hospital includes specialized departments for trauma care, orthopedic surgery, pathology, radiology, clinical support, and pharmacy services. It also serves as a teaching site for medical students through the Northern Medical Program.
